

Proof of Emancipation and/or Legal Guardianship

You have indicated on your FAFSA that you may be an emancipated minor or in legal guardianship. An emancipated minor will have been legally (through the courts, not an attorney) released from control of their parent or guardian. Students in legal guardianship are NOT in legal care of their parents.

For both of these instances proof of Emancipation or Legal Guardianship will be the legal document as determined by a court of law.
